

Fishing Schooner Grounds, Crew Saved.

BEAUFORT, N. C., Aug. 14.—The fishing schooner Louise Howard, from New York, went aground today in a half gale off Beaufort Bar. The crew of ten men was taken off by the Coast Guard, despite the heavy sea. The schooner was to have engaged in shark fishing and carried nearly a ton of dynamite, her commander said.
